Installing The Plugin.

Installing the plugin is like installing any other WP plugin.

Step 1: Go to the "Plugins" section and click.

Step 2: Click "Add New" and Upload the included zip file.

Step 3: Activate it.

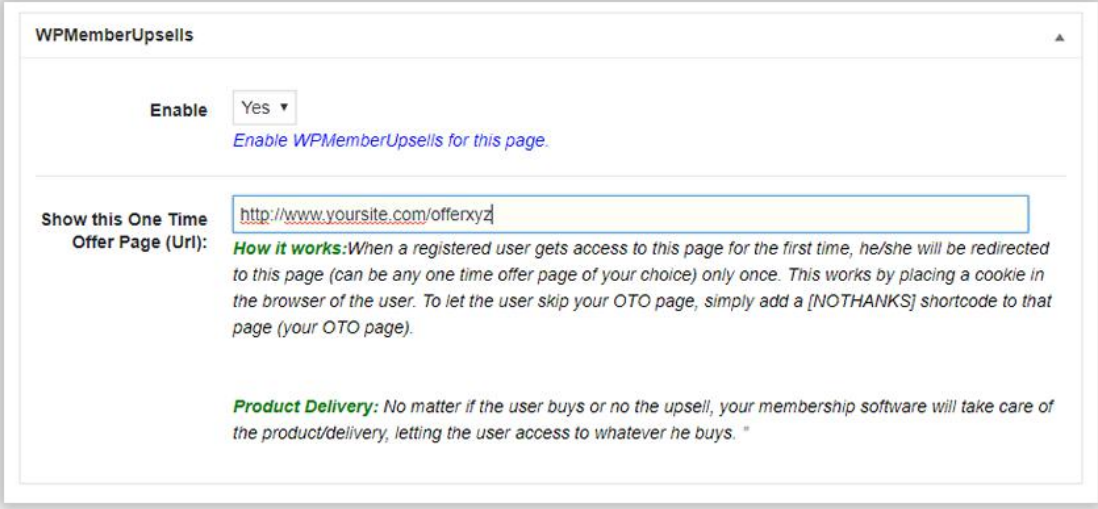
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Using The Plugin.

Using the plugin is really easy.

Just go to any wordpress page (or post) and enable the WPMemberUpsells Option.

Then enter a url (where you have an upsell) that you want to show to the visitor the first time that he arrives to this page.

Then click “Publish” and that’s all.



Some Comments.

The OTO page will show once per visitor and per page (each page can have its own OTO page).

The OTO page will show for registered users only (you need to have a WP Membership Plugin).

You should add a “No Thanks” link to your OTO page so your users can skip your OTO and they can return to the previous page.

You can do this by placing a **[nothanks]** shortcode inside your OTO page.

This shortcode will show a “No Thanks” link that will let the user skip your OTO.

This link won’t be visible if you access to your OTO page directly (you need to come to it from another page - to make a test, create another test, make a link to your OTO page and then follow it).

It doesn’t matter what the user buys (if he buys your OTO’s or not), your membership plugin should take care of the product delivery (this is why the software is designed to work with a WordPress Membership software).
